Hi All!

It was voted at the Selectmen's meeting on Wednesday, 1/20 that the Town of Ashland's Rubbish/Recycling fees would be adjusted, as follows:

Regular base fee (billed annually) will increase from \$138.00 per household to \$156.00 per household **Effective FY11 to be billed 8/2010******

Senior (abated) base fee (billed annually) will increase from \$48.00 per household to \$86.00 per household **Effective FY11 to be billed 8/2010******

Bag prices will be adjusted, as follows:

Large (33 gal.) bags will increase from \$6.50 per roll of 5 bags to \$9.00 per roll of 5 bags **Effective Monday, February 1, 2010******

Small (14 gal.) bags will increase from \$3.75 per roll of 5 bags to \$5.25 per roll of 5 bags **Effective Monday, February 1, 2010******

I just missed the deadline for the February edition of The Ashland Directions. I have this information on the website and there was a write up in the Metrowest Daily News on Thursday, 1/21.
